We want opposing teams to look forward to playing our teams because our players, coaches and supporters participate in a positive way that increases the enjoyment of the game we love. This is "The Rossmoyne Way". This message is especially important as we head toward the finals series. Anxiety and competitiveness may heighten so it is important to remember that this is weekend sport and the main aims for our players should be friendship, fun and to learn and grow as a player and team member.
